

KANSAS SONS OF THE AMERICAN LEGION
U.S. "Udie" GRANT SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The name of this fund shall be the "Kansas Sons of the American Legion U.S. "Udie" Grant Scholarship Fund". The fund will "be used by The Sons of the American Legion for the purpose of assisting financially, in the education of needy and worthy children or grandchildren of Sons of the American Legion members of the Detachment of Kansas or members of the Sons of the American Legion of the Detachment of Kansas".

RULES

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

1. Any high school senior, undergraduate college student, or SAL member who is a US citizen is eligible to apply.
2. The applicant should be an average or better student scholastically.
3. High School seniors, undergraduate college students, and adults holding High School Diplomas and/or College credits who are enrolled or intend to enroll in an approved Junior College, College, University or Trade School located in the state of Kansas will be considered.
4. The applicant must be the son, daughter, grandson, or granddaughter of a member of the Kansas Sons of the American Legion or a member of the Kansas Sons of the American Legion for the past three (3) consecutive years. (Please attach copy of current year's membership card of the member from whom eligibility is derived.)
5. The applicant may obtain eligibility through a deceased member whose membership was paid up in The Sons of the American Legion in the year of death. (Please attach certification from Squadron Adjutant.)

TYPE OF SCHOLARSHIP

1. One scholarship granted for the 2010-11 school year.
2. Grants are not renewable, but can be applied for on a yearly basis.

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP

1. One (1) \$500.00 scholarship, \$250.00 at the start of each semester in any one school year.

TO STAY ELIGIBLE

1. Must maintain a C average in College or advancement in Trade school, and submit verification at the end of each semester or term.
2. Verification from school of enrollment at the start of each semester.

HOW TO APPLY

1. Applications must be received in The American Legion Headquarters, 1314 Topeka Ave., Topeka, KS 66612, **by February 15, 2010.**
2. Two letters of recommendation – Only one letter of recommendation from a teacher.
3. Certified High School transcript – **MUST SHOW GRADE POINT AVERAGE AND ACT/SAT SCORES (if available).**
4. A written essay of not more than 500 words on "What Your Goals in Life Are and Why You Want To Attend College" must accompany application. Essay must be signed and dated.
5. List of Leadership and Extracurricular Activities in High School and Honors or Awards you received.
6. Latest 1040 income statement of supporting parent(s) or proof of income/financial need statement.
7. Copy of current membership card in the Kansas Sons of the American Legion or Adjutant's certification.

HOW CHOSEN

1. After all applications are received at Department Headquarters they will be forwarded to the Sons of the American Legion Scholarship Committee.
2. The Committee will review and select the winning applicant based on the above criteria.
3. The decision of the Scholarship Committee shall be final and absolute.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The applicant's major or field of study will be a factor in the final selection. Please indicate your anticipated major or field of study.
2. The Committee reserves the right to waive certain disqualifying requirements.
